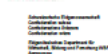

EUFRUIT is a project financed in the framework of the Horizon2020 research and innovation programme, and started in March 2016 with a duration of 3 year.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- 21 partners out of 12 European countries
- To **coordinate** and **support** innovation in the fruit sector and ensure integration across the research-to-market chain of the fruit sector
- 4 thematic areas:
 - ✓ **New cultivar** development and evaluation
 - ✓ Reducing use of chemicals during production phase to **minimise residues** on fruit and in the environment
 - ✓ Optimising postharvest handling, **storage and quality** attributes of fruit
 - ✓ **Sustainable production systems** and approaches across a range of key European fruit species
- The EU fruit project intends to establish a network of relevant stakeholders to address key challenges for the fruit sector
